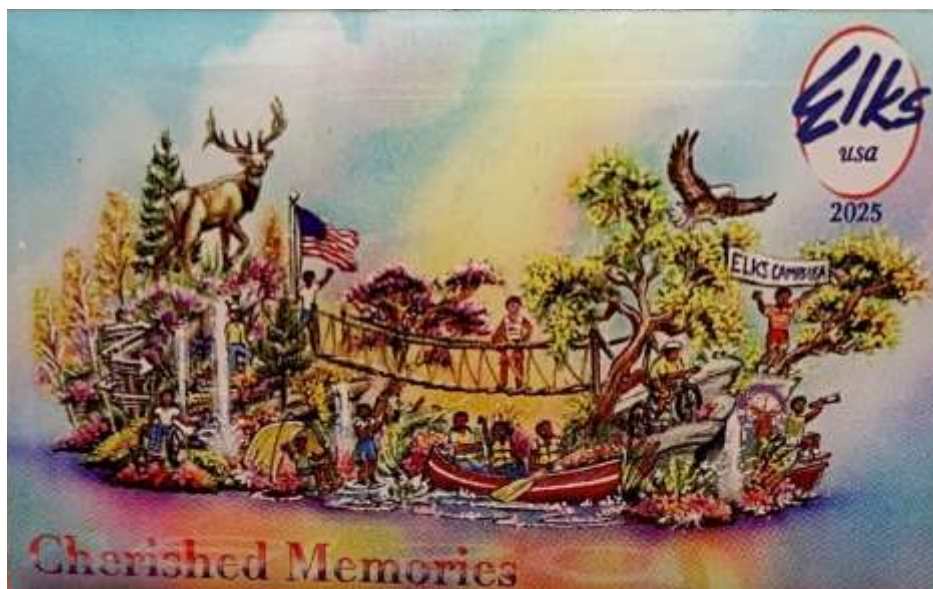
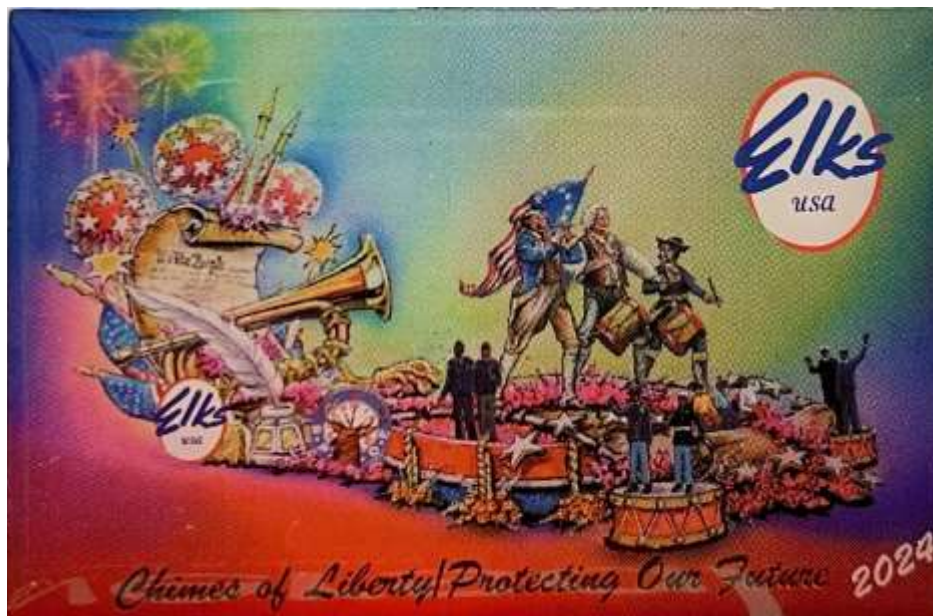

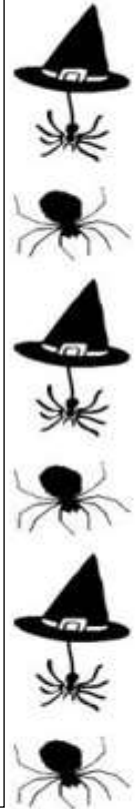


Witches invade the Elks!
