Happy Birthday America. The Elks have always been a patriotic organization and this month we celebrate the birth of our GREAT nation. Independence Day, known as the 4th of July, is commemorating the Declaration of Independence, which was ratified by the Second Continental Congress on July 4, 1776. The Declaration of Independence was prepared by a committee of Five. They asked Thomas Jefferson to author its first draft. Jefferson largely wrote the Declaration of Independence in isolation over 17 days between June 11, 1776, and June 28, 1776. Congress debated and revised the wording and finally approving it two days later on July 4th.

In a remarkable coincidence, Thomas Jefferson, and John Adams were the only two signatories of the Declaration to serve as presidents of the United States and both died on the same day: July 4, 1826, which was the 50th anniversary of the Declaration. Although not a signatory of the Declaration of Independence, James Madison, another Founding Father who was elected president, also died on July 4, 1831, making him the third President who died on the anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. The only U.S. President to be born on July 4th was Calvin Coolidge, who was born on July 4, 1872. In 1778, from his headquarters at Ross Hall near New Brunswick, New Jersey, General George Washington marked the 4th of July with a double ration of rum for his soldiers.

We had a good turnout on Memorial Day and at the Pancake Breakfast. This was a day of reflection, remembering those who died serving our Country. The holiday stems from the Civil War, which killed more than 600,000 service members, both Union and Confederate between 1861-1865.

Flag Day was held on Sunday, June 9th. Unfortunately, there was not a good turnout of our members. A big thank you goes to the Boy Scouts for the outstanding job they did, the band, as always, did a wonderful job, the Officers for giving up their Sunday afternoon, and to Carla Ugarte for serving the refreshments.

We will not be having a dinner on Wednesday evening July 3rd, and will not be having a Pancake Breakfast in July, but will have one on Labor Day. I am hoping there is a great member and family turnout.

I think most members do not realize how much work goes into preparing breakfast. The volunteers arrive about 6 a.m. and work until 11:00- 11:30 a.m. I want to THANK everyone who worked at the breakfast on Memorial Day weekend. You did a FANTASTIC job! and I thank you and thank you. Working together brings us closer together.

Some members are asking why the Father's Day luncheon was cancelled. Members were not interested.

On the other hand, on Friday, June 7th, a Veterans Stand Down/Resource Fair was held, here at the lodge. What a turnout! I am sure that the lodge's Veterans committee with the County of San Mateo Veterans Services felt it was a job well done. The Elks spend over sixteen million dollars yearly to bring encouragement, cheer and comfort to veterans throughout the United States in fulfillment of their solemn pledge: "So long as there are Veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them."

We do have other events coming up which I hope you will attend. We will have the 4th of July BBQ on Thursday, July 4th, Friday July 5th, "Friday Night BBQ" 4:30 - 6:30 p.m. where reservations are required, adults \$15.00, children 6-12 years \$10.00.

Saturday July 13th, "Chili Cook Off". Tasting starts at noon, \$10.00 per person. Vote for your favorite chili! Contact Mike Dees at (650)533-9212.

These activities help us help Veterans, give scholarships, give grants for higher education to children of deceased Elks, drug education programs, and in-home service for the care and treatment of children and adults with physical disabilities including vision and speech problems.

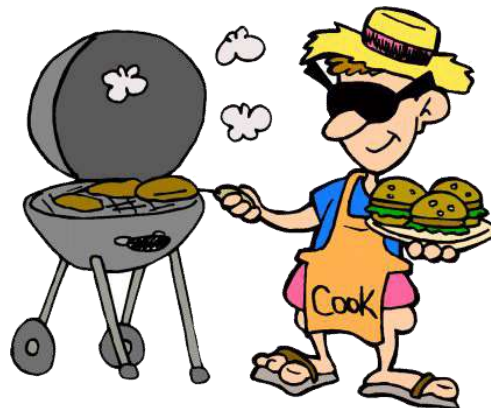

2024 Hillsdale High School Hall of Fame Inductee



Chuck Borrecco

HHS Faculty '60 – '94

Chuck attended College of the Sequoias, and Fresno, San Francisco, and San Jose State Universities. At Hillsdale he served as a teacher, coach, mentor, and leader, and earned a reputation as one of Hillsdale's Faculty Icons. Chuck is best known as Hillsdale's "Mr. Auto Shop" where he taught generations of students, many of whom chose careers in the industry. He also taught Drivers' Education and math, and helped develop and taught Principles of Technology, an innovative course combining Physics and Industrial Technology. Chuck coached F-S Baseball and 130's Basketball with his teams winning Mid-PAL championships in 1962/3 and 1963/4. The Hillsdale faculty honored Chuck by awarding him the Teacher of the Year "Golden Apple" in 1962 and choosing him as one of two teachers to represent Hillsdale in Washington DC to accept the prestigious National Blue-Ribbon School Award in 1993. Finally, Chuck was a co-founder of the Alumni's Olde Knights' Luncheon in 1996 and has been instrumental in its continuing success.
